Privacy Notice for CCTV Surveillance

(CCTV Privacy Notice)

PPP Green Complex Public Company Limited

PPP Green Complex Public Company Limited (hereinafter referred to in this Notice as the "Organization") is operating Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras for surveillance monitoring within and around the premises of the Organization's buildings, facilities, and locations (the "Premises") for the protection of life, health, and property. The Organization collects personal data of officers, operators, customers, employees, contractors, visitors, or any other individuals (collectively referred to hereinafter as "you") who enter the Premises through the use of such CCTV devices.

This CCTV Privacy Notice ("Notice") provides information about the collection, use, or disclosure of data that can identify you ("Personal Data"), as well as your rights, as follows:

1. Legal Basis for Processing Personal Data

The Organization collects your Personal Data under the following legal bases:

- Necessity to prevent or suppress danger to the life, body, or health of you or other persons
- Necessity for the legitimate interests of the Organization or other persons, where such interests are not less significant than your fundamental rights in Personal Data
- Necessity to comply with applicable laws governing safety and the working environment and the Organization's property

2. Purposes for Collecting Your Personal Data

The Organization collects your Personal Data for the following purposes:

1. To protect your personal health and safety, including your property
2. To protect the Organization's buildings, facilities, and property from damage, disruption, destruction of property, or other crimes
3. To support relevant authorities in law enforcement for the purposes of deterrence, prevention, investigation, and legal proceedings
4. To assist in dispute resolution arising during disciplinary or grievance procedures
5. To assist in investigation procedures or procedures relating to complaints
6. To assist in initiating or defending civil proceedings, including but not limited to legal proceedings related to employment
7. Other purposes (if any)

3. Personal Data Collected and Used by the Organization

In accordance with the purposes stated in Section 2, the Organization installs CCTV cameras in visible locations and places warning signs indicating the use of CCTV at entrances, exits, and areas the Organization deems necessary for surveillance, in order to collect your Personal Data when you enter the Premises, as follows:

Categories of Personal Data Collected:

- Still images
- Video footage
- Audio recordings
- Images of your property, such as vehicles, bags, hats, clothing, etc.

The Organization will not install CCTV cameras in areas that may unduly violate your fundamental rights, including bedrooms, restrooms, shower rooms, or rest areas for personnel.

4. Disclosure of Your Personal Data

The Organization will keep CCTV footage relating to you confidential and will not disclose it, except where necessary to fulfil the surveillance purposes specified in this Notice. The Organization may disclose CCTV footage to the following categories of persons or entities:

8. Competent authorities as prescribed by law, to assist in law enforcement or for the purposes of investigation, inquiry, or various legal proceedings

9. External service providers, where necessary to ensure the prevention or suppression of danger to the life, body, health, and property of you or other persons

5. Your Rights under the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019)

The Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019) aims to give you greater control over your Personal Data. You may exercise your rights under the Act once the provisions relating to data subject rights come into force, as detailed below:

10. Right to access, obtain a copy, and request disclosure of the source of your Personal Data held by the Organization, except where the Organization has the right to refuse your request by law or court order, or where your request may cause damage to the rights and freedoms of other persons
11. Right to request correction of your Personal Data that is inaccurate or incomplete, to ensure it is accurate, current, complete, and not misleading
12. Right to request suspension of the use of your Personal Data in any of the following cases:
 - 3.1 During the period when the Organization is examining your request to correct your Personal Data to be accurate, complete, and current
 - 3.2 Your Personal Data has been collected, used, or disclosed unlawfully
 - 3.3 When your Personal Data is no longer necessary to be retained for the purposes the Organization stated at collection, but you require the Organization to continue retaining it for the exercise of your legal rights
 - 3.4 During the period when the Organization is proving to you the legitimate grounds for collecting, using, or disclosing your Personal Data, or examining the necessity to collect, use, or disclose your Personal Data for public interest purposes, arising from your exercise of the right to object
13. Right to object to the collection, use, or disclosure of your Personal Data, except where the Organization has lawful grounds to refuse your request (e.g., the Organization can demonstrate that the collection, use, or disclosure of your Personal Data has legitimate grounds that override your rights, or for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims, or for public interest purposes in accordance with the Organization's mission)

6. Retention Period for Personal Data

To achieve the purposes of CCTV surveillance as specified in this Notice, the Organization will retain CCTV Personal Data relating to you for a period of 1 month from the date of the situation, condition, or event used to determine the retention

period — for example, when building staff have completed a retrospective review. The said period is in accordance with the retention periods required by relevant laws, regulations, practices, and rights (please specify such sources clearly). Upon expiry of the said period, the Organization will delete and destroy your Personal Data.

7. Personal Data Security

The Organization has implemented appropriate technical and administrative measures to protect your Personal Data from loss, or unauthorized access, deletion, destruction, use, alteration, modification, or disclosure, in accordance with the Organization's Information Security Policy.

In addition, the Organization has established a Personal Data Protection Policy announced throughout the Organization, along with guidelines to ensure security in the collection, use, or disclosure of Personal Data, maintaining Confidentiality, Integrity, and Availability of Personal Data. The Organization periodically reviews the said policy and this Notice as appropriate.

8. Responsibilities of the Data Controller

The Organization has designated only those officers with authority relating to the collection, use, or disclosure of Personal Data for this processing activity to be able to access your Personal Data. The Organization will ensure that such officers strictly comply with this Notice.

9. Amendments to the Privacy Notice

In updating or amending this Notice, the Organization may make changes as it deems appropriate and will notify you through www.pppgc.co.th, with the latest version date noted at the end. Nevertheless, the Organization recommends that you regularly check to receive the latest Notice, especially before entering the Organization's Premises. Your entry into the Premises constitutes your acknowledgment of the terms of this Notice. Please refrain from entering the Premises if you do not agree with the terms of this Notice. If you continue to enter the Premises after this Notice has been amended and published through the above channel, you shall be deemed to have acknowledged such changes.
