Privacy Notice for Website Users of PPP Green Complex Co., Ltd. (Public Company)

PPP Green Complex Co., Ltd. (Public Company) (hereinafter referred to as the “Organization”) places great importance on the protection of personal data. To assure you that the Organization will protect and handle your personal data in accordance with personal data protection laws, the Organization has prepared this Privacy Notice to inform you of the details of the processing (collection, use, and disclosure) of personal data that may occur while you visit the Organization’s website, as well as to inform you of your personal data rights and the Organization’s contact channels.

1. Purposes for the Collection, Use, or Disclosure of Personal Data

When you access the Organization’s website, the Organization may collect, use, or disclose your personal data for the following purposes:

1.1	To use the website or access the Organization's various systems and those of group companies, or to connect to other websites of the Organization, group companies, or external agencies.	Legitimate Interests Contractual Basis

1.3	To analyze, research, and develop the Organization's products, services, and activities to better suit your needs, including collecting website usage data to analyze user behavior for website development and communication strategies.	Legitimate Interests
1.4	For risk management, compliance oversight, internal audit by the Internal Audit Office, and internal organizational management.	Legitimate Interests
1.5	Where you wish to visit the Organization's operations, the Organization may process your personal data for coordination, consideration, selection and confirmation of the visit, and to prepare appropriate facilitation for the visiting group.	Legitimate Interests
1.6	Where you submit information through the Organization's contact channels or make various requests (e.g., requesting information from an information center), the Organization may process your	Legitimate Interests

1.7	When you download certain documents from the Organization's website (e.g., annual reports, sustainability reports), the Organization may request additional personal data for contact and survey purposes, to gather opinions and improve its reports.	Legitimate Interests
1.8	When you access the Organization's website, the Organization may need to collect, use, or disclose certain personal data for legal compliance, investigation, legal proceedings, and reporting or disclosure to government agencies, independent organizations, or other bodies exercising legal authority or court orders, including to establish, exercise, or defend legal claims.	Legal Obligation Legitimate Interests

If the Organization collects personal data necessary for the performance of a contract or legal obligations and you do not provide such data, the Organization may be unable to provide or facilitate services for you.

2. Collection of Personal Data and Types of Personal Data That May Be Collected

When you access the Organization's website, personal data may be collected. Some may be collected automatically (e.g., IP address, browser type), and some may be provided by you through forms determined by the Organization or for relevant activities such as inquiries, requests for information, or requests to visit the Organization's operations. The Organization may also collect personal data through its data processors or from other sources such as publicly accessible sources or data obtainable from government agencies.

The Organization may collect the following personal data:

2.1 General Personal Data

- (1) Identity Data – e.g., name, surname, national ID number, age, date of birth.
- (2) Employment Data – e.g., occupation, company/organization name, position/department.
- (3) Contact Data – e.g., address, telephone number, email.
- (4) Account Credentials – username and password (only when accessing the Organization's or group companies' systems).
- (5) Technical Data – electronic device data, IP address, log data, browser type and settings, location data, online identifiers for enabling 'cookies' and similar technologies.
- (6) Other Data – e.g., country of user, application form data, questionnaires, opinions, satisfaction ratings, or details of inquiries or requests submitted to the Organization.

2.2 Sensitive Personal Data

In general use of the Organization's website, the Organization does not intend to collect or use sensitive personal data (e.g., religion, ethnicity) of you or others for any specific purpose. You are not required

to specify or mention such data. However, if the Organization needs to use such data for any purpose, it will notify you and request your consent on a case-by-case basis.

Where you have provided a copy of your national ID card containing sensitive personal data such as religion and blood type, the Organization generally does not intend to collect and use such data for any specific purpose. If you provide a copy of your national ID card, please redact such information. If you have not redacted it, you are deemed to authorize the Organization to redact it, and the document with such data redacted shall be fully valid and legally enforceable. If the Organization is unable to redact the data due to technical limitations, it will collect and use such data solely as part of your identity verification document.

3. Retention Period for Personal Data

The Organization will retain your personal data for as long as necessary for the purposes of collection, use, or disclosure as specified in this Notice, and may retain it further as required for legal compliance or statutory limitation periods, to establish, exercise, or defend legal claims, or for other reasons in accordance with the Organization's internal policies and regulations.

4. Disclosure of Data

In carrying out the purposes specified in this Notice, the Organization may disclose your data to the following external parties:

4.1 Group companies of the Organization, for the purpose of achieving the stated objectives.

4.2 Government agencies, state entities, independent organizations, regulatory bodies, or other legally mandated bodies, including officials exercising legal authority such as courts, prosecutors, and police.

4.3 Agents, contractors/subcontractors, and/or service providers for any operations on behalf of the Organization, such as auditors, lawyers, legal advisors, website developers, and public relations contractors.

5. International Transfer or Disclosure of Data

The Organization may store data on computer servers or clouds of service providers located abroad and may process data using software or applications of overseas service providers. In any case of such transfer or transmission, the Organization will comply with the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019).

6. Accessing Other Websites via the Organization's Website

This Privacy Notice applies solely to the services and use of the Organization's website. If you visit other websites even through links on the Organization's website, the privacy protection will be governed by the privacy notice of those websites, which is unrelated to the Organization.

7. Cookies and Similar Technologies

The Organization uses strictly necessary cookies for the operation of its website to collect and store data when you visit the website. The Organization also intends to use optional cookies to help improve its website; however, optional cookies will not be used until you grant permission. Additionally, the Organization's website may use Google Analytics to analyze website usage data and improve the Organization's website. You may review details of cookie usage in the Organization's Cookie Policy.

8. Your Rights as a Data Subject

As a data subject, you have rights under the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019). You may exercise your rights through the channels specified by the Organization in Section 10 or via the Organization's website, once the personal data protection law becomes applicable to the Organization. Your rights are detailed as follows:

8.1 Right to Withdraw Consent

Where the Organization requests your consent, you have the right to withdraw consent for the processing of personal data at any time, except where withdrawal is limited by law or a contract that benefits you.

Withdrawal of consent does not affect personal data processing already lawfully carried out based on your prior consent.

8.2 Right to Access

You have the right to access and receive a copy of your personal data held by the Organization, and to request that the Organization disclose how it obtained such data without your consent.

8.3 Data Portability Right

You have the right to request the Organization to transfer your personal data as permitted by law.

8.4 Right to Object

You have the right to object to the processing of data concerning you for cases of collection, use, or disclosure of personal data as permitted by law.

8.5 Erasure Right

You have the right to request the Organization to delete your personal data as permitted by law. However, the Organization may store personal data electronically and some systems may not support deletion; in such cases the Organization will arrange for destruction or anonymization of the data.

8.6 Right to Restrict Processing

You have the right to request the Organization to suspend the use of your data as permitted by law.

8.7 Rectification Right

If you believe the data held by the Organization is inaccurate or you have changed your personal data, you have the right to request the Organization to correct it so that it is accurate, current, complete, and does not cause misunderstanding.

8.8 Right to Lodge a Complaint

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent official under the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019) if the Organization violates or fails to comply with the said Act.

9. Amendments to This Notice

The Organization may amend this Privacy Notice from time to time. When any amendment is made, the Organization will announce it on its website. Where consent is required, the Organization will also seek your additional consent.
